
MHA Screening

- Began in April 2014.
- Access to screening tools is free and anonymous at www.mhascreening.org.
- Most screeners voluntarily give de-identified demographic data.
- Screeners are young, (73% < 25 years), female (73%).
- Help-seeking population (74% positive).
- Otherwise, representative of the population.



Number of People Looking for Help Increased Dramatically in 2020

Total Number of Screens 2014-2020






Largest Increases in Parent/Youth, PTSD, Anxiety and Substance Use

Screen	Percent Scoring At Risk 2019	Percent Scoring At Risk 2020
Parent	60.53%	69.70%
Youth	70.94%	77.06%
PTSD	84.18%	89.59%
Anxiety	74.22%	78.82%
Alcohol or Substance Use	78.32%	81.55%



Young People Disproportionately Experiencing Depression and Anxiety


Percent Scoring Moderate to Severe
